Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre (CPAC)

It was a day like any other, coffee in hand, trawling the internet for spooky happenings when I got a message from my Australian Paranormal Phenomenon Investigators (APPI) co-founder, Peta Banks, which read – ‘Found this from an old security guard of Casula Powerhouse – “I used to lock and alarm that place back when I did mobile security patrols. Nothing worse than being there by yourself after midnight, about to set the alarm when you can clearly hear footsteps upstairs. However, alarm sensor panel says place is empty. Go back to base and tell the story and the other guys reckon I got off easy. They all tell stories of hearing screaming from upstairs and even seeing moving objects. The place gives you the creeps just driving down to it.” Let’s do it. – Peet’. APPI is constantly on the lookout for interesting locations to investigate and this was definitely one of them.

Liverpool Powerhouse was built in 1951, later renamed Casula Powerhouse. It was used to supplement electricity supply and shortages. It ceased operation in 1976 and was purchased in 1978 by Liverpool Council for \$75,000. It sat derelict until capital works began in 1987, turning it into an arts centre. Over the years, further works have been

carried out to make it the centre you see today...yet its history haunts its grounds.



The signs to get in and investigate this venue couldn’t be any clearer, so I phoned CPAC and had a very interesting conversation with the Business Manager. He told me of a man who was crushed to death whilst undertaking his duties as powerhouse employee. The location of this man’s tragic death is still visible today. The Business Manager went into detail of the numerous reports from staff,

artists and visitors of sightings of apparitions, disembodied whisperings, doors banging when the building is supposedly empty and the sound of work boots stomping along the metal runways. Even the Business Manager had his own experiences which he shared. After countless hours of research, a long run of meetings and negotiating we had an investigation date.

Eleven investigators had unprecedented access to the centre on 1st October 2011. Out of that eleven, ten people experienced the phenomena of seeing either a streak or ball of white light with the naked eye at various times during the night. Throughout the investigation we had static cameras set up in vital points of the centre and the only anomaly in hours of footage was one single streak of white light. We have tried all ways possible to debunk this light, but can't. The investigation night was a success with a large array of experience and evidence.

When presenting CPAC with the investigation outcome we included, at their request, a ghost tour proposal. They were impressed with what they saw and immediately set up a night to run a trial tour with all staff and their partners. This was a great night and the staff loved to hear the history and ghostly happenings. What made it an even better night was that the staff felt comfortable enough to approach us to let us know of their spooky experiences. With each tour we seem to be able to add more experiences to our script as many of our guest's report of their hauntingly great time at CPAC.

Weather and Geothermic Conditions that Affect Paranormal Activity

Could it be possible that a ghost, or an astral being is a compilation of many different elements?. Perhaps it is the essence and energy of a previously living being lacking all of it's physical senses.

It has been documented during paranormal investigations that astral beings need energy to manifest and consequently they tap into whatever energy is available to them. This energy can come from a variety of electrical sources such as appliances and batteries; also they may be utilizing energy emanating from human beings and/or the atmosphere within the immediate area. That is one explanation why paranormal activity often coincides with vast fluctuations in the surrounding temperature.

Did you know that weather, including solar and lunar activity, is also known to play a role in the occurrence of paranormal activity?

Geomagnetic fields and solar storms are believed to have a strong effect on astral beings and increase paranormal activity.

The geomagnetic field is the magnetic field observed in and around the earth. A geomagnetic storm is a worldwide disturbance of the earth's magnetic field which has the capacity to increase paranormal activity. Solar storms are caused by the sun creating solar flares that send charged particles to the earth, which causes a magnetic shift increasing the geomagnetic fields. With increased geomagnetic fields the hypothesis is that spirits can utilise this energy and become more active and can more easily interact with our world.

Thunderstorms can also aid in the increase of paranormal activity. One can certainly appreciate the power involved in such an event, and you can literally see the electrical charge in the atmosphere. It is no surprise

then, that this is a highly conducive time to experience paranormal phenomena but obviously most of us don't want to be standing exposed in the middle of a graveyard during a raging thunderstorm. However, if you ever find yourself in a position to do some indoor investigation during a good storm, chances are that you will achieve at least some measure of success in these types of conditions.



Even if you can't time an investigation to coincide with a thunderstorm, it most definitely wouldn't hurt to drag out the compass, digital camera, and whatever other equipment you have next time you are sitting at home during a strong storm. You may be surprised at the results.

As far as moon phases and the question of what phases are best for paranormal sightings, some investigators suggest that the full moon is by far the most conducive time to experience ghostly phenomena. There are many theories as to why this is, from the air being more saturated with positive ions, to the added gravitational pull on the earth and the tides.

The dark moon is also conducive for experiencing paranormal phenomena; from a shamanic perspective the dark moon is a period of time when one can walk between the worlds. The Dark Moon is historically a time of underworld journeys and it seems

logical that ghosts would be more noticeable at this time of the moon's cycle.

The equinoxes and solstices every year have also been known through history to be very favorable to supernatural occurrences. These events are extremely important cosmically and it is no wonder that they are considered very powerful days in supernatural terms.

It is believed by many that the whole winter season is a very active time of the year for paranormal activity. The ancients believed that winter is a time when the veil between the worlds is thinner. This thinness of the veils allows the astral beings to penetrate the physical world much easier than in warmer periods. Halloween for example is a festival that exemplifies this belief.

In order to maximize the potential of a successful investigation all of the above 'conditions' need to be incorporated into your observations to see if there is a pattern that can be identified in increased activity of the paranormal. Cases will vary, of course, and even they may be dependent upon the susceptibility or sensitivity of given witnesses to observe a given manifestation; but such manifestations do frequently occur world wide and there is too much evidence to discredit the existence of ghosts. So if you want to be a paranormal investigator, check out the moon phase, the weather and geothermic conditions, grab your equipment and head off to a haunted location! It may prove very productive.

The Murder House

Flicking through the realestate.com, advertisement reads: 'Commanding a striking street presence in a blue ribbon location, this quintessential Federation residence has been sympathetically renovated with exquisite appointments and generous proportions. Beautiful characteristics are in abundance, from stunning fretwork arches to bay windows, fireplaces, ornate staircase, decorative high ceilings to parquet and tessellated tile flooring. The extensions have been impeccably done to the finest detail - it is impossible to see where the original house ends and the extensions begin', sounds divine! What the agent hasn't divulged is the murder suicide that took place there 3 years ago. The current owner's report of being woken from their sleep by doors slamming, footsteps up and down the hall and shadow figures at the end of their bed. The property has been listed for sale for 12 months now and the price reduced several times with prospective buyers advising the agent that the house doesn't quite 'feel' right.

In 2004, L.J. Hooker Ryde were fined \$20k for selling the Gonzales murder home to a Taiwanese couple for \$800k neglecting to outline its history. In New South Wales, Section 52A of the Conveyancing Act 1919,

states that a seller of residential property must disclose defects in title and defects in quality of title by way of documents and certificates attached to the contract of sale.

This section is meant to include properties where a murder, suicide, violent crime or other horrific event has occurred at the property. The Taiwanese couple managed to pull from the sale and the property was re-listed with this - "Notice to Buyers: This property is being sold under instructions from the Trustee of the Estate of the Late Teddy and Mary Gonzales. Mr and Mrs Gonzales together with their daughter were murdered in the house on 10/7/01." The property eventually sold to a mystery buyer for \$720k after two long years on the market.

In August 1969, one of the most infamous crimes of the 20th century occurred. The Manson Family went on its first murder spree in a bungalow in Benedict Canyon, Beverly Hills. This was the home of heavily pregnant Sharon Tate and movie director Roman Polanski. In the early 90s this property was sold at full value. The new owner could not resist the stunning views of Los Angeles and not long after purchase tore the home down and built a 10,000-square-foot Mediterranean mansion. A prime example of no matter how

heinous the crime, eventually things can return back to suburban normality.

In the dusty country town of Junee NSW stands Monte Cristo Homestead. Many have heard its legend; many have spent a night under its harrowing tin roof. After a hot meal lovingly prepared by Olive Ryan, her husband, Reg Ryan takes you on the tour of the homestead and its grounds. Between the awe of the antiques and the chilling stories of death and murder it's a property that leaves an imprint for sure. A wonderful example of embracing a property with a tainted legacy and opening it for all to experience...as well as making a pretty penny...for the upkeep of course.

In 1999 police discovered the remains of eight bodies in barrels in various states of decomposition stored inside the vault of a disused bank at Snowtown, Adelaide. There were eleven Snowtown murder victims in total with one murder actually occurring in the bank itself. This was a high profile horrific case so prospective buyers would have to be living under one hell of a rock to not know what they were getting into. This property

recently sold for \$200k, with the new owner planning to live in the adjoining home and utilising the bank for a business. They have stated that they plan on placing a plaque on the vault in memory of those found there.

So it would seem that personal preference would dictate the choice of 'buyer beware', 'business as usual' or 'horroportunity'. The downside for those of us who are interested the morbid side of life is that once a location is torn down it's gone forever. The physicality of its gruesome history is nothing but a story. For those that are re-used, we can live in hope that they become available sometime in the future. Fair enough that the bio-cleansing companies do their duty of removing the various elements of persistent decomposition and the tell-tale human outline from the hardwood floor. The reputation of a murder house will linger leaving owners no choice but to make alternative solutions necessary, or, turn it into a tourist destination...being the true-crime 'buff slash paranormal' enthusiast I am, I personally prefer the latter.

HAUNTED SITES IN SYDNEY

THE ABBEY, ANNANDALE

When I was a child living in the inner city I spent a good time roaming the streets of Annandale. There are lots of impressive homes in the inner city and I found I had an innate sense of knowing what houses were haunted in the area. There is one particular house that always seemed to catch my attention as I walked passed it – ‘The Abbey’ a Victorian revivalist manor which was spookily swathed in Boston ivy and stood out like a beacon at the bottom of Johnston Street. The Abbey was one of eight homes built by John Young, a builder who had migrated from England to Australia. These houses were known as the Witches houses because of their peculiar roof design that looked like Witches hats: The Abbey, Oybin, Kenilworth, Rozelle (now demolished), Greba, Hockindon, Highroyd and Claremont (now demolished).

The Abbey loosely modelled on a Scottish manor was the most outstanding of these homes. This manor contains a Gothic vault and a tower with gargoyles and it was

rumoured that Young had stolen the gargoyles from St Mary’s cathedral that he was working on to use on his Annandale homes. An interesting point is that Young was a Freemason and had decorated the manor with Masonic symbols. The manor was completed in 1882.






Young had built the home to impress his wife and encourage her to return from the UK. Sadly she did not return and they never lived in it. The Abbey was occupied by housekeepers while Young lived in a house called Kentville, near Rozelle Bay, which has since been demolished. From 1887, the ballroom and stables of The Abbey were used as a boarding house for private schools.

Unfortunately the mansion was subdivided and converted to flats and fell into a state of disrepair. In 1959, the property was acquired by radio engineer Lancelot Davis for his son, Sydney surgeon Dr Geoffrey L R Davis. The Davis family occupied The Abbey for 50 years. Dr Davis died in 2008. The house was sold to new owners in November, 2009, for \$4.86 million.


Ms Davis the previous owner claims the house is haunted. She says she has felt various presences from time to time. Doors open and windows close on their own, visitors catch glimpses of dark shadowy figures, and a Lady in White has been seen in the vault and also roams the halls. The seven children all experienced the ghosts, especially the Lady in White. The basement and the main bedroom are evidently notorious for paranormal activity.

Origins of Ouija

I laid eyes on my first Ouija board in my early teens. Scared of the unknown yet taunted by the planchette we settle in and asked questions, the board seemed to answer...spirits were talking to us. Needless to say my tender years and fear got the better of me and I backed away from the board quick smart. A lot older and hopefully a lot wiser, the skeptic in me uses the Ouija in paranormal investigating experiments.

One of the earliest forms of this method of divination was 'Fuji', from the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644). This consisted of spirit-writing using a suspended sieve or winnowing tray, directing a stick or stylus, typically made from a willow or peach branch to receive messages from beyond. The Chinese Fuji spirit-writing involved a specialised vocabulary comprising mainly symbols. This form of divination ended up being prohibited by the Qing Dynasty (1644). Another historical account of Ouija origin comes from 540 B.C. where it is said that Greek philosopher Pythagoras conducted séances on a specially designed table with wheels, which would move towards signs and symbols providing messages from the next world.

In 1886 an article in The New York Times stated that Mr Charles W Kennard of Chestertown MD USA, used his wife's breadboard and a saucer to speak with the dead. This handmade 'talking board' became the craze of Ohio four years before its supposed true discovery. Kennard went into business in 1890 as the Kennard Novelty Company, and in early 1891 acquired the rights to the first 'talking board' patent, registered by Elijah J Bond. Kennard went on to sell his share of the business and the board fell into the hands of one William Fuld who renamed the business Ouija Novelty Company.



In 1927, Fuld died a mysterious death. It is believed he suffered complications from falling off a three story building. It had been suggested that Fuld's tragic death was due to the evilness of the Ouija board and he had actually suicided. The rumours surrounding his death only served to boost Ouija sales. The Ouija boards patent passed hands from the Fuld family to Parker Brothers in 1966, who's operations location of Salem, Massachusetts, further added to the boards mystery. In Parker Brothers first year of manufacturing, Ouija outsold Monopoly with over two million boards sold. In early 1999, Parker Brothers stopped manufacturing the classic Fuld Ouija board and switched to a tacky glow in the dark version. Gone is the intricate detail and the name William Fuld. The traditional Ouija boards are now prized collector items.

There are two main schools of thought on how the Ouija board operates. One is the belief that the board serves as an aid to contacting the spiritual realm. The other is the belief that it is a way to get in touch with one's own subconscious. Although commercially introduced as a harmless parlour game, a Ouija board in any shape or form is a source of criticism and controversy. Fundamental Christians say that the board is a portal to the devil. Harry Houdini himself wrote in 1924 that he knew of five people in California who were driven clinically insane by using the Ouija board. One would wonder of their mental state and level of perception before 'playing' with the Ouija board.

English physician William Benjamin Carpenter coined the term 'Ideomotor Effect' which refers to the influence of suggestion or expectation on involuntary and unconscious motor behaviour. Ideomotor Effect has been around for over 150 years but is not a commonly known theory. It can be used to explain the physiology and psychology to make divination a delusional concept. It is a classic example of how we can be misled by our senses to trust in an apparent reality. When one has a personal experience it is more real to them than any other as they trust in the perceived infallibility of their own senses. In any event the Ideomotor Effect is a good example of why, when investigating and using equipment we should use objective, scientific testing rather than rely on subjective, personal experience to work out what is real and what is not.

The intrigue and mystery of the Ouija draws many into its realm. Whether you sit right or left wing in belief, feel it's a portal for the devil, use it for divination or investigating the paranormal...bear in mind the Parker Brothers slogan: "It's only a game—isn't it?".



What is Parapsychology?

Defining parapsychology is not an easy task as each paranormal researcher has his or her own hypothesis. Parapsychology over the past century has been involved in a variety of studies including ESP (extrasensory Perception), mind-matter interaction (previously known as psychokinesis, including near-death experiences, apparitions, reincarnation, remote viewing and UFOs).

The modern study of parapsychology which began over 100 years ago has been undertaken by researchers examining thousands of case studies and formal experiments to come to better understanding of these paranormal events but there has been very little focus on the social impact these events have on society.

Researchers have painstakingly recorded countless thousands of attempts to apprehend, predict, or influence random events in laboratory settings. They have gathered powerful statistical evidence to validate the various paranormal hypothesis, and have developed theories and models to explain how they might occur, however, nothing significant has been done to deal with these phenomena phenomenologically (a philosophy or method of inquiry based on the premise that reality consists of objects and events as they are perceived or understood in human consciousness and not of anything independent of human consciousness).

In general Parapsychologists believe that further research will eventually explain these anomalies in scientific terms, although it is

not clear whether they can be fully understood without further developing and expanding our current scientific knowledge. There are those researchers however, that believe that the current scientific models of perception and memory are adequate to explain most or all parapsychological phenomena.



The term “parapsychology” was created by psychologist Max Dessoir around 1889, and it first appeared in an article written by Dessoir, “Die Parapsychologie. Eine Entgegnung auf den Artikel “Der Prophet,”” which appeared in June 1889 (translation: Parapsychology. A Response to the Article “The Prophet”). Researcher J.B. Rhine probably did the most to popularize the term parapsychology in English and he was one of the first to engage in large-scale, organized study of the subject.

Parapsychological phenomena can incorporate the following general categories: telepathy, clairvoyance or precognition, and telekinesis. Telepathy is the ability to communicate information across space by the power of the mind alone. Telekinesis is the ability to move objects by the power of the mind alone. Clairvoyance or precognition (from 17th century French with clair meaning “clear” and voyance meaning “vision”) is used to refer to the ability to gain information about an object, person, location or physical event through means other than the known human senses, a form of extra-sensory perception.



There is also a belief system called Spiritualism that believes that spirits of the dead have both the ability and the inclination to communicate with the living. This belief system is closely related to the accepted view of parapsychological phenomena, with the ability to speak with spirits of the dead which is often accompanied by moving objects and predictions of the future.

Interestingly, parapsychological research grew out of numerous attempts to scientifically investigate the performances of spiritualists and mediums.

Many scientists broke away from traditional spiritualists point of view: while the spiritualists insisted that their activities proved the existence of an afterlife and the soul, the scientists insisted that their activities were actually evidence of previously unknown powers of telepathy, telekinesis, and clairvoyance. Even today this split between the two remains, despite their common origins.

Much of what lies behind parapsychology is the belief that the mind is independent of the body and that the field has the means of proving the truth of a non-materialistic conception of life and the universe — the same premise that drives spiritualism.

What is interesting, and what makes parapsychology and so-called psychic phenomena so difficult to research, is that each of these categories are often viewed from a non believers or skeptics perception and therefore is usually defined in a negative terms.

The Edinburgh Vaults

During September of 2012 the SOuL Searchers team were lucky enough to be able to spend some time in Edinburgh. Auld Reekie, as it used to be known has a tragic and murderous past; a far cry from the beautiful city that greeted us with its cafe's, boutique shops and restaurants.



However under the streets of this vibrant city lurks a dark past that remains to this day.

The poor and downtrodden of the day, unable to stand the stench of above ground living turned to the vaults under the South Bridge. Built in the 18th century this subterranean slum was a place for storage but proved too tempting for those with nowhere else to go.



It soon became a place of easy pickings for those darker sides of society. Murder, rape, theft, bodysnatching were commonplace in an environment where even the local police (who were hired thugs themselves) were too scared to go.

The area also has a darker side to witchcraft and many practices were thought to occur. Practices that would not have been tolerated outside of the slums.

Today the Niddry street vaults are a must to do for anyone interested in the history and the paranormal. The "auldreekitours" provided an excellent opportunity to explore the narrow passageways and storage rooms that housed so many people.



The pictures above were taken on my full spectrum camera. The tour was set up so that very few people were present and this helped gain a sense of the presences that

were tangible down there. The guide also allowed photography so both canon digital and full spectrum was used.

My first experience was also my most profound as a paranormal investigator to date and came as always at a most unexpected time. During the guides discussion within a storage room I was able to see beyond into the next room leading to a corridor. As I looked from the guide to the room beyond a man was standing looking towards our group. He had long hair and a white loose cotton shirt although the legs were not clearly visible. He looked briefly our way and then moved out of view into the corridor. The whole experience lasted about four seconds and made my hairs stand up on end. I raised

my hand and interrupted the guide to ask if there were any other groups in the vaults. He said no and I explained what I had seen by which time he was looking into the corridors only to find that there was no-one there.

All the time that we had been in the vaults we had been taking a large amount of photographs and interestingly nothing was captured on the standard digital cameras.

While reviewing the pictures taken with the full spectrum however I came across two pictures that were noteworthy and worth further investigation. Both I have added below but note that reproducing in this magazine format will make it harder to discern.

Looking through the doorway above a mist can be seen at approximate head height. I leave this for others discuss and welcome feedback.




