Sydney Ritual

Invocation to Macha:

Macha help us to be sovereign of ourself.

Help us to stand up for what is right, while maintaining compassion.

May we realise our self-empowerment without falling into boastful traps.

Macha grant us vision to see what is within,

and your wisdom to be with us in all that we do.

Help us in our transformations to be more fully ourselves

and yet to be more like You.

Invocation to Nuada

Oh great Nuada, who lost your arm in battle who bled and suffered and returned the next day to fight again, one-armed. Help us find the strength within to overcome our own obstacles. May we find the strength of will to keep fighting against all odds. May we find the strength within to turn our pain to power. Nuada, come join us tonight. Hail and Welcome!

Intent - Nuada's sword is seen as the embodiment of justice. Looking beyond the physical, it could be thought as a tool to cut straight to the heart of a matter, thus symbolising the wielder's power to dispense justice, truth and law. The aspect of light suggests illumination, in other words, wise and sacred knowledge. At this ritual we will be wielding our power to dispense justice on issues that have been blocking us for sometime, bringing illumination where it is needed and freeing us up in order to bring balance in our lives.

Meditation

Activity - Each person's hands were bound together with string to represent the ties that bind. Nuada then went around the circle asking each person if they were ready, then the string around their wrists was cut (with scissors by Nuada's "assistant") and Nuada used a sword to touch each person's shoulders (like a knighthood ceremony) conferring our ability to find our strength within. When Nuada had completed the circle we then lit sparklers and waved them around to represent our swords of light. This was followed by a drumming session.
