Opening of the Circle (Maria)

Walk the circle once, saying:

***By the power of the Dragons of the Sea
may this circle be blessed cleansed and
sanctified.***

Walk the circle once again, saying:

***By the power of the Dragons of the Land
may this circle be blessed cleansed and
sanctified.***

Walk the circle for the third time, saying:

***By the power of the Dragons of the Sky
may this circle be blessed cleansed and
sanctified.***

WEST: Wolf (Beverley)

***Wolf Spirit of the West, Great Spirit of
the Water, we ask that you join us this
night. May your compassion and
generosity flow throughout this circle,
help strengthen and bring peace to our
hearts. Hail and Welcome.***

NORTH: Bear (Simon)

***Bear Spirit of the North, Great Spirit of
Fire; we ask that you join us this night.
May your courage and strength inspire
this circle, so that we may be stimulated
by these attributes. Hail and Welcome.***

EAST: Eagle (Janine)

***Eagle Spirit of the East, Great Spirit of
the Air; we ask that you join us this
night. Help us fly high to bring us
nearer to the Great Mystery and we ask
that you guard and protect us on our
journey and inspire our visions. Hail
and Welcome.***

SOUTH: Salmon (Samantha)

***Salmon Spirit of the South, Great Spirit
of the Earth, we ask that you join us this
night. Help us to be wise in transforming
ourselves and to bring creativity and
fertility into this circle. Hail and
Welcome.***

GODDESS: Mother Earth (Jenny)

***Welcome Mother Earth, Keeper, and
protector of all life. Your generous gift of
life year after year, and month after
month, sustains us and provides for us.
We ask you for your blessings, and aid on
this night. Hail and Welcome.***

GOD: Father Sky (Ray)

***Welcome Father Sky, Keeper, and
provider of light and energy. Your
warmth, and life sustaining energy helps
us and all life to grow.
We ask you for your blessings and aid on
this night. Hail and Welcome.***

Meditation

Drumming

Visualise that your drum/musical instrument has a thread connecting it to the Sky/Earth bowl in the centre. We are now going to drum energy into the bowl.

After the drumming

Jenny picks up the bowl holding it in her hands & Ray places his hands on top of the bowl. They both say together:

We send this energy to the Earth for healing.

Ray then takes the lid off the bowl & says:
Take a Dream Catcher so that you may catch your dreams.

Jenny walks around the circle offering the bowl for everyone to take a Dream Catcher.

Closing

SOUTH: Salmon (Samantha)

Salmon Spirit of the South, Great Spirit of the Earth, thank you for joining us this night and helping us to be wise in transforming ourselves and for bringing

creativity and fertility into this circle. Hail and Farewell.

EAST: Eagle (Janine)

Eagle Spirit of the East, Great Spirit of the Air; thank you for joining us this night and helping us fly high to bring us nearer to the Great Mystery. Thank you for guarding and protecting us on our journey and inspiring our visions. Hail and Farewell.

NORTH: Bear (Simon)

Bear Spirit of the North, Great Spirit of Fire; thank you for joining us this night and for your courage and strength that inspired this circle, and for the stimulation of these attributes. Hail and Farewell.

WEST: Wolf (Beverley)

Wolf Spirit of the West, Great Spirit of the Water, thank you for joining us this night and for your compassion and generosity that flowed throughout this circle, helping strengthen and bring peace to our hearts. Hail and Farewell.

Drumming & singing:

May this circle be open but unbroken
May the peace of the Goddess be ever in our hearts.

Merry Meet and Merry Part
And Merry Meet again.
